SPRING AND SUMMER 2005 PLAYING SCHEDULE

The team handball playing schedule in the US consists of a series of tournaments that occur at about once or twice a month. The tournaments are held year round, and are always played on weekends. US team handball clubs must be invited to be allowed to participate in a tournament, and usually either the very good clubs or the clubs that play regularly are invited. The partnership between GT Team Handball and the American Handball Association ensures that Georgia Tech will at least get the opportunity to prove itself. Due to the small size of the sport in the US, both Collegiate and Amateur clubs play in the same circuit.
